## In re: George M. Allen

## FINAL ORDER

On June 21, 2021, the Presiding Disciplinary Judge of the Supreme Court of Colorado issued an order suspending George M. Allen from the practice of law for two years. *See People v. George M. Allen*, 20PDJ048 (Co. 2021). Mr. Allen reported this suspension to this Court as required by Rule 83.2(e) of the Rules of the United States Court of Federal Claims ("RCFC").

Mr. Allen has been a member of this Court's bar since October 13, 2004 and has one case pending before this Court, *McCluskey et al. v. United States*, No. 19-1516L, before the Honorable Edward J. Damich. Under RCFC 83.2(c)(2), an attorney may be disciplined based on an act or omission that results in the disbarment or suspension of the attorney by another court.

On July 27, 2021, the Court issued an order directing Mr. Allen to show cause within 30 days why he should not be suspended from the practice of law before the United States Court of Federal Claims. ECF No. 2. The Order to Show Cause further stated that if no response was received, Mr. Allen would be suspended from practice. *Id.* Mr. Allen filed his response on August 27, 2021 and filed additional materials on September 3, 2021. ECF Nos. 3, 4.

In consideration of the representations made in Mr. Allen's response, as well as the fact that Mr. Allen's pending matter in this Court is stayed awaiting the resolution of a companion case in the United States District Court for the District of Colorado, the Standing Panel on Attorney Discipline has determined that Mr. Allen shall remain suspended until such time as the stay in the *McCluskey* matter is lifted. If upon the lifting of the stay in *McCluskey* the Standing Panel finds that no additional disciplinary actions have been brought against Mr. Allen and that Mr. Allen has complied with the terms of his Colorado suspension, the Standing Panel will vacate Mr. Allen's suspension.

IT IS ORDERED that George M. Allen shall, pending further order of the Standing Panel, remain suspended from the practice of law before the United States Court of Federal Claims for two years, *nunc pro tunc*, June 21, 2021, the date of his suspension in Colorado. Mr. Allen is directed to notify the Standing Panel promptly once the stay in *McCluskey* has been lifted.
