## FINAL ORDER

On March 4, 2022, the Supreme Court of California entered an order suspending Leland Alan Stark from the practice of law for a period of 9 months. *In the Matter of Leland Alan Stark*, State Bar Court Case No. 20-O-30477 (Ca. 2022). Mr. Stark subsequently had two additional matters opened against him, which were consolidated and have been abated. See *In the Matter of Leland Alan Stark*, State Bar Court Case Nos. 22-N—30026 and 22-O-30433 (Ca. 2022). Mr. Stark did not notify this Court of his suspension as is required by Rule 83.2(e)(1)(B) of the Rules of the United States Court of Federal Claims ("RCFC"). The Court learned of Mr. Stark's suspension on April 18, 2022.

Mr. Stark has been a member of this Court's bar since July 30, 1981 and has no pending cases. Under RCFC 83.2(c)(2), an attorney admitted to practice before this Court may be disciplined for an act or omission that results in the attorney's disbarment or suspension by another court. In addition, under RCFC 83.2(c)(4), an attorney may be disciplined on the grounds of failure to comply with the terms of RCFC 83.2, including failure to notify the Court in accordance with RCFC 83.2(e).

On August 25, 2022, the Court issued an order directing Mr. Stark to show cause within 30 days why he should not be reciprocally suspended from the practice of law before the United States Court of Federal Claims. ECF No. 3. The Order to Show Cause further stated that if no response was received, Mr. Stark would be suspended from practice. *Id.* To date, Mr. Stark has not responded to the Order to Show Cause. Therefore,

IT IS ORDERED that Leland Alan Stark is suspended from the practice of law before the United States Court of Federal Claims for a period of 9 months effective, *nunc pro tunc*, April 18, 2022, the date this Court received notice of his suspension in California. The filing of any petition for reinstatement will be governed by RCFC 83.2(k)(1).
