1. The CM/ECF system is for use only in those cases designated by the U.S. Court of Federal Claims as electronic cases. The system may be used to file electronic documents and to view documents, docket sheets, and notices.
2. Each attorney desiring to file pleadings or other papers electronically must complete and submit an Account Registration Form. An attorney must be a member of the court's bar to register.
3. An attorney's login and password issued by the court serves as and constitutes the attorney's signature. Therefore, an attorney must protect and secure the password issued by the court. If there is any reason to suspect the password has been

compromised, it is the duty and responsibility of the attorney to change the password immediately and to notify the court.

4. Although the court manages the procedures for electronic filing, all public access to electronic case files occurs through the Public Access to Court Electronic Records (PACER). A PACER login is required in addition to the CM/ECF password issued by the court. To register for a PACER account, a user must complete the online form or submit a registration form, available on the [PACER](#) website.
5. By submitting this registration form, the registrant agrees:
  - a) to abide by all of the rules and procedures set forth in [Appendix E, RCFC](#) and the [User Manual for Attorneys](#); and
  - b) to service by electronic means.

This registration form will expire if all conditions for registration are not met within 30 days from the date submitted. The court will send the registrant a login and password via e-mail to the address listed on this form once all registration conditions are met.
