

On November 26, 2012, following respondent's concession in her Rule 4(c) report that petitioner is entitled to compensation in this case, Respondent's Report, filed Nov. 21, 2012, at 5, I ruled that petitioner had established the statutory requirements for entitlement. Ruling on Entitlement at 2. In light of the parties' settlement negotiations, I did not issue a damages order.

On December 10, 2012, respondent filed a Proffer on Award of Compensation ["Proffer"] indicating the parties' agreement on the amount to which petitioner is entitled. Pursuant to the terms stated in the Proffer, **I award petitioner: a lump sum payment of \$80,000.00 in the form of a check payable to petitioner, Linda Collier,** representing compensation for all damages that would be available under § 300aa-15(a).

The clerk of the court is directed to enter judgment in accordance with this decision.³
