
NOTICE OF PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO RULES

Pursuant to 28 U.S.C. §§ 2071(b) and 2503(b), the United States Court of Federal Claims hereby provides notice that it proposes to amend its rules and invites public comment on the proposed amendments. The amendments (i) adopt the changes in rule structure and word usage that were introduced as restyling changes into the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure on December 1, 2007; (ii) introduce technical changes into RCFC 3, 3.1, 5.4, 7.2, 13–16, 24, 26, 32, 40.3, 53, and 55, and minor changes in scope or content (including changes to conform to the FRCP) into RCFC 4.1, 5, 5.5, 7, 9, 12, 23, 25, and 40.2 (these changes are identified in each affected rule’s 2008 Committee Note); and (iii) add two new rules, RCFC 5.2 (“Privacy Protection For Filings Made with the Court”) and RCFC 71 (“Enforcing Relief For or Against a Nonparty”), each reflecting the language of its FRCP counterpart.
