## **GENERAL ORDER**

Upon consideration of current circumstances relating to the ongoing COVID-19 pandemic; to supplement this court's Order of March 16, 2020, restricting public access to the Howard T. Markey National Courts Building, setting out temporary procedures, and altering the rules of the court; and to amend the court's Order of May 12, 2020, requiring proceedings to be conducted by telephone conference or video conference through June 15, 2020, I further DIRECT that:

- (1) All proceedings in this court scheduled to occur before July 6, 2020, shall be held by telephone conference or video conference unless express permission has been granted by the Chief Judge of the court.
- (2) Attorney admissions scheduled in court ceremonies through July 6, 2020, are cancelled. Petitions for admission to the bar of this Court will continue to be accepted through PACER and will be processed as soon as practicable.
- (3) The Chief Judge of the court may amend or rescind this order at any time if circumstances so warrant.
- (4) The Clerk of Court is directed to provide public notice of this Order and to take any necessary and proper actions to implement these restrictions.
