

to a presumption of causation, as Nasir's encephalitis first manifested within five to fifteen days of his receipt of his first MMR vaccine, and there is not a preponderance of evidence that his condition is due to a factor unrelated to his MMR vaccine." *Id.* She adds that his "encephalitis has persisted for greater than six months." *Id.* at 5.

In view of respondent's concession and the evidence before me, I find entitlement to compensation based on a Vaccine Table injury. 42 C.F.R. § 100.3(a)(III)(B). A separate damages order will issue.
