

Motion at 2. In her motion, petitioner explained that the evidence on which she expected to rely “is the same as that presented by Thomas Hennessey.” *Id.* at 2. Petitioner acknowledged that in Mr. Hennessey’s case, which served as a test case for evidence of a causative link between the hepatitis B vaccine and T1D, I found that petitioner did not demonstrate that vaccines can cause T1D or significantly aggravate an underlying condition of T1D. See *Hennessey v. Sec’y, HHS*, No. 01-190V, 2009 WL 1709053 (Fed. Cl. Spec. Mstr. May 29, 2009), *aff’d*, 91 Fed. Cl. 126 (2010). Petitioner has therefore requested that I dismiss the above-captioned petition. Petitioner’s Motion at 1.

To receive compensation under the Program, petitioner must prove either 1) that Trevor suffered a “Table Injury” – i.e., an injury falling within the Vaccine Injury Table – corresponding to one of his vaccinations, or 2) that Trevor suffered an injury that was actually caused by a vaccine. See §§ 300aa-13(a)(1)(A) and 300aa-11(c)(1). An examination of the record did not uncover any evidence that Trevor suffered a “Table Injury.” Further, the record does not contain a medical expert’s opinion or any other persuasive evidence indicating that Trevor’s alleged injury was vaccine-caused.

A petitioner may not receive a Program award based solely on the petitioner’s claims alone. Rather, the petition must be supported by either medical records or by the opinion of a competent physician. § 300aa-13(a)(1). In this case, because there are insufficient medical records supporting petitioner’s claim, a reliable medical opinion must be offered in support. Petitioner, however, has offered no such opinion.

Accordingly, it is clear from the record in this case that petitioner has failed to demonstrate either that Trevor suffered a “Table Injury” or that his injuries were “actually caused” by a vaccination. **Thus, this case is dismissed for insufficient proof. The clerk shall enter judgment accordingly.**
