## UNPUBLISHED ATTORNEYS' FEES AND COSTS DECISION1

Petitioner, Tara Hannebaum, filed an application for attorneys' fees and costs on December 10, 2008. She is awarded the amount to which respondent has not objected.

Mr. Hannebaum seeks a total of \$27,200.15 in attorneys' fees and \$2,256.71 in attorneys' costs. Additionally, Ms. Hannebaum filed a statement of costs in compliance with General Order No. 9, stating that she incurred \$309.52 in litigation costs. Respondent stated that he had no objection to the application for attorneys' fees and costs.

After reviewing the request, the court awards **\$29,766.38** in attorneys' fees and other litigation costs. The court thanks the parties for their cooperative efforts in resolving this matter.

The Clerk shall enter judgment accordingly.<sup>2</sup>
