FINAL ORDER

On August 17, 2016, the Supreme Court of Pennsylvania ordered that Norman Orville Scott be suspended from the Pennsylvania bar for six months, citing his neglect of several clients in violation of the Pennsylvania Rules of Professional Conduct and the Pennsylvania Rules of Disciplinary Enforcement. Mr. Scott was on probation in Pennsylvania—a sanction for his failure to diligently represent prior clients—when the suspension order was issued.

Pursuant to RCFC 83.2(g)(6), an Order to Show Cause was issued by this court on October 6, 2016, directing Mr. Scott to show cause within thirty (30) days why the court should not impose discipline identical to that imposed by the Supreme Court of Pennsylvania. To date, Mr. Scott has not responded to this order. Therefore,

IT IS ORDERED that Norman Orville Scott shall be suspended from practice before the Court of Federal Claims for a period of six months, effective, *nunc pro tunc*, August 17, 2016. RCFC 83.2(c)(2). Reinstatement is not automatic. The filing of any petition for reinstatement is to be governed by RCFC 83.2(k).

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Acting Clerk of Court shall serve Norman Orville Scott with a copy of this order.
