**ORDER**


On June 11, 2015, the District of Columbia Court of Appeals approved a petition for negotiated attorney discipline and ordered Alexander Djordjevich suspended from the practice of law for a period of nine (9) months, with reinstatement conditioned upon Mr. Djordjevich demonstrating his fitness to practice law. The Court of Appeals noted that while Mr. Djordjevich had admitted to violating numerous rules of the District of Columbia Rules of Professional Conduct, the court also found that Mr. Djordjevich had voluntarily ceased practicing law, had paid restitution to his clients, and had fully cooperated with Bar Counsel.

On September 17, 2015, the Court of Appeals of Maryland also ordered Mr. Djordjevich indefinitely suspended from the practice of law in Maryland with reinstatement to the Maryland Bar predicated upon his reinstatement to the District of Columbia Bar. On November 18, 2015, the United States District Court for the District of Maryland also ordered a reciprocal indefinite suspension of Mr. Djordjevich.

Pursuant to Rule 83.2(g)(6) of the Rules of the United States Court of Federal Claims (RCFC), an Order to Show Cause was issued by this court on February 17, 2016, directing Mr. Djordjevich to show cause within thirty (30) days why he should not be indefinitely suspended from practice before the United States Court of Federal Claims, effective, *nunc pro tunc*, June 11, 2015, the date the District of Columbia Court of Appeals approved his petition for negotiated attorney discipline. On February 25, Mr. Djordjevich responded by saying he had no objection to the imposition of reciprocal discipline to that imposed by the District of Columbia Court of Appeals. Therefore,

IT IS ORDERED that Alexander Djordjevich is indefinitely suspended from practice before the United States Court of Federal Claims, effective, *nunc pro tunc*, June 11, 2015. The filing of any petition for reinstatement is to be governed by RCFC 83.2(k) and is further conditioned upon Mr. Djordjevich's reinstatement to the District of Columbia Bar.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Clerk of Court shall serve Alexander Djordjevich with a copy of this order.
