



reasonable basis for the petition. See 42 U.S.C. § 300aa–15(e)(1). Ms. Bunch satisfied the reasonable basis standard by filing reports from Dr. Steinman.

After reviewing the request, the undersigned finds the requested amounts reasonable. Petitioner is awarded attorneys' fees and other litigation costs. Those fees and costs are awarded as follows:

1. **A lump sum of \$84,003.68 in the form of a check payable to petitioner and petitioner's counsel of record, the law firm of Rawls & McNelis, P.C.;**
2. **A lump sum of \$18,915.00 in the form of a check payable to petitioner and petitioner's former counsel of record, the law firm of Shoemaker & Associates, and**
3. **A lump sum of \$5,316.99 in the form of a check payable to petitioner only.**

The court thanks the parties for their cooperative efforts in resolving this matter.

The Clerk shall enter judgment accordingly.<sup>2</sup>
